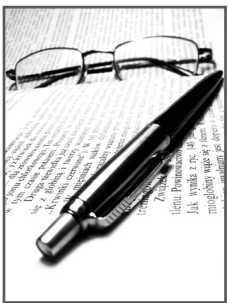




How to Apply for Copywriting Jobs
