In middle school, the counselors will work with students to improve grades as well as behaviors. These people will intercede on behalf of the students and will be an advocate for them when needed.

They will work with students to help them identify their strengths and weaknesses and help them consider the best classes to take in school. Testing is an important part of children's lives at this age and the school counselor helps children understand the necessity of taking different tests and they help them understand what the results are showing.

As a high school counselor the job shifts focus slightly and helping students stay in school and get into college are two of the biggest challenges. These counselors often have a large number of students for whom they are responsible. They offer counseling on an individual basis as well as in group settings and help students who are dealing with problems at home, in class or with peers.
