The department confirms that the wholesale and retail sector contributed about 37% of the gross domestic product (GDP) last year, which jumped up by 16% from 13% in nominal terms and from six to eight percent in real terms. Reports also suggest that the department strongly believes that securing people's jobs is crucial in the development of various industrial sectors.

"The hustle and bustle in recruitment activity, especially in the financial services and real estate sector, has slowed down drastically now," says A. Harrison Barnes, founder and CEO of DubaiCrossing. "The big-shot companies in Dubai are taking necessary precautions to face the tide of the downturn which is prevalent in other countries. Few are resorting to cost-cutting beforehand to combat the recession, which might sweep them badly later.
