The unemployment rate in Pennsylvania is less than the national unemployment rate of 5.5%; Pennsylvania has been holding steady at 5.2% for the past two months. Industrial employment in Pennsylvania has been suffering considerably, however, dropping by 1.2% over the year, according to the *2009 Pennsylvania Manufacturers Register*, a compilation of state industry reports published annually by Manufacturers' News, Inc. (MNI). Additionally, 10,684 industrial jobs were lost over the year from May 2007 to May 2008, continuing the decline the state has seen since 2001.

Service-providing industries reported the largest gains in the job market with a rise of 1,400 jobs in education and health services, and 1,200 jobs in professional and business services. The service-providing industries have helped the job market show consistent gains in the number of jobs for the last three months.

"Pennsylvania has been trying to combat the deteriorating employment situation with renewed vigor" says A. Harrison Barnes, CEO of EmploymentCrossing. "Pennsylvania's industrial sector is suffering due to automation and outsourcing, and although they are trying hard, the jobless rates have not dipped as of now."
