EngineeringCrossing Witnesses Big Jump in Newly Added Engineering Jobs

Pasadena, CA — The engineering job market looks to be strong in 2008. New engineering jobs have been added across the country, and this trend is plainly evident on EngineeringCrossing, a leading job-search website and career portal (www.engineeringcrossing.com).

EngineeringCrossing, the engineering field's fastest-growing job board, with more than 98,000 engineering jobs, including positions for structural engineers, manufacturing engineers, and systems engineers, among others, has witnessed a boom in new job listings over a recent two-month period. And new engineering jobs are being added to EngineeringCrossing daily. In just the past seven days, more than 13,000 new engineering job listings have been added to the site. This increase is a good indication that last year's growth in engineering jobs will continue into 2008.
