The [Bureau of Labor Statistics](http://www.bls.gov/oco/oco2003.htm) [http://www.bls.gov/oco/oco2003.htm] also reports that over the next eight years, government jobs are projected to increase by 4.8%, from 10.8 million to 11.3 million.
